Ottawa, 25th Fovember, 1913:

Sir,-

I beg to inform you that you are hereby appointed medical officer to Indians of the Mississanga River Reserve and also to Indians of the Serpent River Reserve. You will be paid a salary of \$400.00 a year for rendering professional services to Indians of the Reserve named, as well as to visiting Indians .. You will be expected to respond to all reasonable calls made upon your services by the Indians, either on the reserve or at your office and attend in all cases brought to your notice by the Indian Agent. You should visit the reserves named at regular intervals in order to have a close over-sight of the general health of the Indians, and when you visit them you should give them advice of a general character with regard to sanitary matters and impress upon them the necessity of keeping their premises clean. Particular attention should be given to bubercular cases in order to overcome so far as possible the ravages of that disease.

You will be expected to give your services in all cases of epidemics and to perform minor operations. You should furnish all medicines required in your Indian practices

It will be necessary for you to make a report at the close of each month with regard to your Indian work, which
