



Ottawa, 2nd May 1914.

Sir,-

With reference to your letter of the 29th ultimo, I beg to say that before authorizing the payment of annuity money to Emily McDonald or Donald, as a member of the Moose Factory Cree Band, it will be necessary for you to furnish full particulars in substantiation of her claim. You state that her Band number is 9, but I may say that the family paid under this number is known by the name of Mecowatch. The name of MacDonald or Donald, does not appear on the pay-list, consequently your statement in letter of the 21st April, that Louisa McDonald (sister of Emily) has been drawing annuity money as a member of the Moose Factory Band is not understood. A full explanation in the matter is required.
