South the shall lie upon him, print or make a Labour Exit Permit or any printed paper purporting to be a blank form of Labour Exit Permit.

Any person leaving or attempting to leave Canada may be accosted by a peace officer, an imagration, customs or excise officer, or any other person designated by the Director to exercise the powers conferred by this section; and if, upon being so accosted, such person fails to establish to the satisfaction of the person so accosting him that

- (a) that a Labour Reit Permit has been granted to him to leave Canada at that time or that he is not required by these regulations to have a Labour Buit Permit to leave Canada; and
- (b) that he has been authorized in writing to leave Canada by the chairman of the Board or that he is not a British subject who is, or who has been at any time since the first day of September, nineteen hundred and thirty nine, ordinarily resident in Canada or that he has not been designated,

person so designated by the Director, is justified in using such force as may be necessary to prevent such person from leaving Canada.
