Confirming my conversation with Col. Whyte in connection with the proposed relocation of a portion of the Chekwelp Indian Reserve No. 26 water supply pipeline, it is understood that an engineer will visit the Reserve when convenient to ascertain whether it is feasible to relocate the pipeline westerly along the road allowance on the north side of Lot "D" and thence southerly along the road allowance along the west ends of Lots "D" and "E" to the tank, and that if feasible the location will be marked on the ground and an estimate of cost provided.
