Superintendent Sharpe has indicated that the Indians of the above-noted Band are engaged in cutting small amounts of timber and engaging the services of a portable mill owned by a non-Indian.

Mr. J.A. Mountain, reference the attached letter, has made application for a mill site on Indian Reserve No. 12, for which he has agreed to pay the sum of \$150.00 annually. The Band, by resolution dated December 7, have consented to a mill site permit for the current year ending March 31, 1957.

I would recommend that a permit be issued in accordance with the wishes of the Band.
