from the Sunny South : further along big pipes of cocoanut oil from Ceylon and India : coral strand ; over there a whole train load of barrels of clear rendered tallow is being warehoused, and with it a car full of packages of costly pungent, fragrant and aromatic, for perfumery purposes ; and, as car after car is relieved of its contents it is not sent away empty, but instead is loaded again just as heavily, with hundreds of boxes of "Comfort" Soap, and whirled away to its destination, which may be to the Atlantic seaboard or golden west.

Just to give you an idea of the vast size of our factories and annexes, let us tell you here that the plant occupies a floor space of over three acres. This will help you grasp the idea of the bigness of our institution.

Standing round about in the factory yards are huge iron storage and receiving tanks, with special protection covers. These great cylinders receive the oils as they arrive, and the chemically-purified lyes as they are manufactured. Steam pumps force the contents of these tanks to the top story of the main building. To it is the pure white tallow is also elevated, and steamed by special process til it runs from the original packages in streams of clear limpid oil. Here, too, are carried the perfumes and other fragrant products which enter into the composition of "Comfort" Soap. Up through story after story of the factory extend enormous metal kettles which, with steam pipes coiled and radiated throughout their great interiors, compose the mechani-
