Sir,

In consequence of a Despatch recently received from His Majesty's Secretary of State for the Colonies, calling for an immediate Return of all Public Officers in this Province, and of their Emoluments for the year 1827; I am commanded by the Lieutenant Governor to direct your attention to my former communications on this subject, and to desire you will transmit to me, with the least possible delay, a Return of the Salary and Emoluments of your Office for the above period, certified under your signature.

I am further commanded to request, that in future, you transmit a similar Return, immediately after the 31st of December in each year, to enable His Excellency to comply with the requisition of the Secretary of State, which directs him to transmit such Returns at the periods above mentioned, for the information of His Majesty's Government.
