The twenty-second annual meet-
ing of the Ontario Bee-Keepers' As-
sociation was held in the Council
Chambers of the City Hall in the
City of Woodstock, Ont., on Decem-
ber 4th, 5th and 6th, 1901.

The President, Mr. John Newton,
in the chair, called the meeting to
order at two o'clock p. m.

At the request of the President,
Mr. W. J. Craig, Editor of the Cana-
dian Bee Journal, invoked the divine
blessing on the meeting.

The Secretary, Mr. William Couse,
read the minutes of the twenty-first
annual meeting held at Niagara Falls
and said: Before the minutes are
