The base plate is of cast iron in the place of sinc or other perishable material and is raised sufficient for the cold air on the floor to pass up through its raised and hollow cone-shape to the stove, and the circulation produced thereby equalizes the temperature of the room.

There are two grates similar to the base of a circular basket. They can be rotated together or separately.

The five can always be re-lighted without re-moving the coal. No screening or sieving, and no waste whatever.


