No ballast, &c burtful to any Ri-Gaspé or County Cape Tourmante, shall be thrown out of naid District and Counties, nor on any Fishing bank, under a Penalty of £20.

III. IV. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that no person or persons shall cast anchor near the shore, or do any thing within the aforesaid limits, so as wilfully to annoy or obstruct the hauling of Seines, or to obstruct or prevent the setting of Nets, nor shall any Nets be wilfully set or placed, so as to prevent or obstruct the hauling of Seines, under the penalty of five pounds, current money of this Province, for every such offence, exclusive of such damor preventing of ages as may be recovered at Law, by the Proprietor or Proprietors of the Seines or Nets which may be thereby injured or destroyed. Provided always, that no such Nets or Seines as aforesaid shall be set or used so as to incommode or obstruct the navigation or anchorage in any Harbour, Roadstead, Cove or place necessary for the common purposes of Navigation.
