That the Clerk of the Crown in Chancery do lay before this House, the Writissued for the election of a Member to Represent the County of Effingham, with the Instrument of Indenture required by the Act of the 40th. Geo. 3d. Chap. Ist to accompany the same, and also such Return as may have been made to the said Writ by the Returning Officer of the County aforesaid.

Mr. Bedard moved in amendment, seconded by Mr. Berthelot,

That all the words of Mr. Coffin's motion after "moves," be struck out and the following substituted in lieu thereof, "That the faid Charles Baptiste Bouc, Esquire, be now heard in his place, upon the means of Justification which he has to offer to this House."

Mr. Bedard then moved the previous question,

That the question be now put, which being agreed unto unanimously by the House,

The question upon the said amendment was put and the House divided.

Yeas II Nays I3

So it passed in the Negative by a majority of two.
