No. 11.—Claimed before former Commission £178 11s.; was awarded £100, but not paid; his claim therefore stands on the unpaid award.

No. 13.—Unpaid award of £303 9s.

No. 14.—Do. £583 0s.

No. 24.—Unpaid award, £250 for goods; the value of the buildings was left by the former Commission for future consideration. £211 12s. 6d. claim on Prevost's Estate.

No. 27.—Claims £300, as due from Dr. Nelson's Estate; £175 for three months' imprisonment, and £25 for additional losses since the former Commission.

Claims £247 12s. 7d. on Dr. Nelson's Estate.

No. 32.—Claims £215 for loss of time whilst in exile.

No. 33.—Claims for damages done in 1841, but no amount stated.

No. 34.—Claims £268 16s. for interest, and £200 profit, on the goods destroyed and pillaged.
