The most notable sucess was obtained in the Jiul Valley where the Teutons have been steadily on the retreat for nearly a week. In a brilliant assault the Roumanians finally succeeded in clearing Szuduk Pass entirely of the enemy driving them back across the frontier into Transylvania.
