TERRIBLE TRAGEDY AT ROYAL WEDDING.

Bomb Thrown at King and Queen Wedding.

MADRID, May 31.-Public re-Aifonso and the Princess Victoria had a terrible dramatic sequel at 2 30 this afternoon as a bomb thrown from an upper window exploded with deadly effect near the coach occupied by the King and Queen. Providentially King Alfonso and Queen Victoria escaped because of an electric wire deflecting the bomb, but at least 16 persons, most of them being of the personal and military escort, and the other spectators, were killed.

The procession had just passed through Maoyo street and was about to turn into the Esplanade leading to to the palace when the explosion occurred, throwing the cortege into inextricable confusion. The royal coach was brought to a sudden stop, the officers and soldiers of the escort stables, leading the Kings favorite falling to the ground about the horses with gold embroidered saddle equerry and horses that had been killed.
