Picturesque Film Coming to Nickel Monday

"LOST AND FOUND" ENACTED ON
ORIGINAL LOCATIONS.

A picturesque and exciting romance of the South Seas is promised at the Nickel Theatre on Monday in Goldwyn's "Lost and Found," written by Carey Wilson, of Goldwyn's editorial department, and directed by R. When he learns she is his daughter he refuses to let her go and Dingo brings on a terrific fight between the whites and the natives on the boat.

Goldwyn has made a big super-feature of "Lost and Found," a photoplay that is bound to rank among the finest achievements of the season. The cast contains the names of a half a dozen of filmdom's leading players—House Peters as Captain Blackbird, Rose Mary Theby as his wife, Pauline Starke as Lorna, George Siegmann as the governor, Antonio Moreno as the American hero, Carl Harbaugh, Mary Jane Irving, William V. Mong and David Wing have excellent roles.

Municipal Council

WEEKLY MEETING.

The regular weekly meeting of the Council was held yesterday afternoon. Mayor Cook presided and Councillors Martin, Outerbridge, Vincombe, Collier, Ryan and Dowden were present.

The residents of Barnes Road and vicinity petitioned for the placing of a light at the junction of the said road with Military Road. The matter was referred to the Lighting Committee for consideration.

Following the protests received with regard to unsanitary condition of stables Maxse Street, the Medical Officer of Health reported the owners have undertaken to remedy the cause of complaint.

P. G. Taylor called attention to the need of repairs being made to retaining wall, John Street. The wall in question is a private one, but as it is bordering on a public thoroughfare, it was decided that the Road Committee with the City Engineer inquire into the matter.

The Medical Officer of Health reported eight new cases of Scarlet Fever and two of Typhoid in the City during the past week.

The Sanitary Supervisor in submitting his weekly report stated that the Department had performed the regular work, and that the cleaning of streets and gutters, grassing and flushing of drains and sprinkling of streets had been attended to, and that upwards of one thousand loads of ashes and garbage had been carted to the various city dumps.

Following the reading of the report of the City Engineer, granting of requisitions and passing of accounts for week, the meeting adjourned.
