He received a couple of broken ribs and internal injuries. There is considerable doubt whether the last two will recover.

heat has given such an impetus to plant life that much of the lateness of the season has already been over-come. The plant beds have shot up with an amazing growth that tobacco growers find they must work long hours to pre-pare their fields in advance of their needs in transplanting. By the close of this week a good start will have been made in the planting of the 1907 crop. The ex-treme heat of midday, however, has not been quite a favorable for the transplant-ing as growers desire, but they are mak-ing the best of the opportunity, in putting out the crop. They find that the plants have acquired an exceptionally fine root during the time they were making slow progress, which will be very much in their favor when transplanted to the fields, as it should take less time to over-come the shock in transplanting:
