Branch Treasurers must remit to me the amount of the regular No. 11 Assessment on or before the 9th day of October, and the Special Assessment on or before the 21st day of October, accompanied with Monthly Assessment Report. Members, and especially officers of branches, are requested to carefully read sections 1, 8, 9, 10 and 11 of our Constitution in order to become acquainted with the regulations regarding Assessments.
