Meanwhile beat an egg thoroughly, and a saltspoonful of salt, one of mustard, a dash of Cayenne and two tablemustard, a dash at Cayenne and two table-spoonfuls of vinegar, by degrees, stirring hard all the time. When the cream is boil-ing hot, pour it on the other ingredients, beat two or three minutes and serve. Good on string beans, chopped cabbage, asparagus, beet tops, or any field salad. For lettuce, etc., make without heating the cream.


