

FRIED TROUT.—Small brook trout may be cooked to perfection with the greatest ease in a kettle of deep fat. They will be a clear golden brown in colour, crisp and delicious in flavour, and there is no danger of breaking or "mussing" them in cooking. This is the very best way of cooking any small fish.

STEWED POTATOES.—Slice the potatoes very thin on a slicer, as for Saratoga potatoes, and leave them in a pan of cold water over night. Skim them out and drop into boiling salted water; boil for twenty minutes and pour off the water. Cover with milk, add a little chopped parsley (or garnish for the table with fresh watercresses), a good piece of butter and a little white pepper. Dish at once, and serve very hot.

DRESSING FOR BOILED GREENS OR SALAD.—Set a cup of sweet cream to heat in a double boiler. Meanwhile beat an egg thoroughly, add a saltspoonful of salt, one of mustard, a dash of Cayenne and two table-spoonfuls of vinegar, by degrees, stirring hard all the time. When the cream is boiling hot, pour it on the other ingredients, beat two or three minutes and serve. Good on string beans, chopped cabbage, asparagus, beet tops, or any field salad. For lettuce, etc., make without heating the cream.


