CONTRACTS OPEN (Continued).

Mr. Menier is expected to arrive at Quebec from Anticosti on or about the 10th prox. A wharf of 400 feet has already been built at English Bay, and orders have been given for the construction of another at Gamache Bay, both of which places are said to be good harbors, and protected from winds from the open. Orders also have been given for new buildings, a school house, smithy, wheelwright's shop, &c. It is understood that all provisions needed will be brought from Quebec exclusively.

The big building erected on King west by the Toronto Lithograph Co. is the subject of a dispute between the company and W. J. Smith and others. Smith, who contracted for part of the work, claims that the company hold a balance of this contract money, and also refuse to pay his claims for extras, which were caused by the change of work demanded by the architect. Other parties have demands, which have all been submitted to the arbitration of John Donogh. The amount involved is between \$1500 and \$1600.

A letter received from Naples correspondents says: "Of spot filberts only choice long nuts are offered for the present in which with a firm offer in hand we might do something at 25s per cwt., c. and f., New York. Long filberts, which come on the market in September, do not appear to be particularly favorable according to what transpires. 


