the two mines. De Beer never regretted his sale, and in the new home which he made for himse'! he was more contented than he would have been had he neglected his stock for commercial pursuits. In the Free State he was my neighbor, and en nonest, straightforward neighbor he proved himself—one of nature's gentlemen. He died in my house on the 20th of June, 1882, in the 52nd year of his age .- Engineering and Mining Journal.




