### MINUTES OF THE SEMI-ANNUAL MEETING OF THE COUNCIL.

The regular semi-annual meeting of the Council was held on Wednesday, 2nd February, 1876, at 10 o'clock A.M., the following members being present:

The minutes of the meeting held 4th August were read, and on motion were adopted.

Business arising out of the minutes was then taken up.

Mr. Miller, on behalf of the Committee appointed at the previous meeting to procure amendments to the Pharmacy Act, reported progress. The Committee were requested to prosecute their labours to secure the desired changes. Several members stated that they had urged their representatives in the Provincial Legislature to do what they could to secure the passing of the Bill.

Mr. Gregory reported for the Committee appointed to revise the By-Laws. He stated that the Committee deemed it advisable not to alter the By-Laws until the amendments to the Act have been secured.

The report was accepted, and the Committee instructed to continue in force.

Mr. Gregory having already reported in the JOURNAL on his visit to Boston as representative at the meeting of the American Pharmaceutical Association last fall, he remarked it would not be
