The Egyptian Government hereby agrees that the British War Memorial Cemeteries shall not be subject to any State or local taxes.

ARTICLE IV

The exhumation of bodies buried in the British War Memorial Cemeteries or War Graves with a view to their transport elsewhere shall only take place agreement with the Commission.
