

### B.11. Relationship with CTC

In International long distance service, CTC and ENTEL have established a revenue-sharing relationship where CTC recognizes as income only its share of the revenues generated under this service., which corresponds to compensation for the use of the local network and for processing, controlling, billing and collecting payment in respect of each international call. Revenues collected on behalf of ENTEL total Ch\$24,133 million in 1989 Ch\$26,121 million in 1990 and Ch\$28,178 million in 1991.

In domestic long distance service, ENTEL and CTC have established an ENTEL provider relationship, in accordance with the prevailing tariff decrees. CTC recognizes all revenues generated by the subscribers utilizing this service and ENTEL bills CTC for the cost of signal transmission through its circuits. These costs are includes in operating cost and expenses.
