CHANGED BETWEEN THE SSEA OF CDA AND THE MINISTER FOR FOREIGN AFFAIRS OF JAPAN IN TOKYO ON SEP 1964. THE NOTES WILL COME INTO FORCE ON SEP20, 1964, AND WILL HELP PROMOTE THE EXCHANGE OF PERSONS BETWEEN THE TWO COUNTRIES.

16. THERE WAS A DISCUSSION OF POLICIES ON EMIGRATION AND IMMIG IN WHICH CDN MINISTERS OUTLINED THEIR COUNTRY'S POLICY ON IMMIG MATTERS, WITH ITS PROVISION FOR THE ENTRY INTO CDA OF TRAINED OR PROFESSIONAL CANDIDATES FROM ANY COUNTRY WITHOUT DISCRIMINATION.

THE CDN MINISTERS OUTLINED CDN PLANS FOR A WORLD FAIR IN MONTREAL IN 1967 AND THEIR HOPE THAT THE JAPANESE GOVT WOULD BE ABLE TO PARTICIPATE.

MINISTERS EXAMINED THE PROGRESS MADE IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF COMMUNICATION SATELLITES, AND THEIR GRATIFICATION WITH THE PROSPECT OF FUTURE COOPERATION BETWEEN THEIR TWO COUNTRIES IN THIS SPHERE.

17. THE MINISTERS OF THE TWO COUNTRIES EXCHANGED VIEWS ON FISHERIES PROBLEMS, WITH REF TO THE POSITION OF EACH COUNTRY AT THE FORTHCOMING MTG OF THE PARTIES TO THE INTERNATIONAL NORTH PACIFIC FISHERIES CONVENTION. THEY EXPRESSED THE HOPE THAT AT THE FORTHCOMING MTG IN OTT AN ACCEPTABLE FORMULA WILL BE FOUND TO MEET THE PROBLEMS FACING THE TWO COUNTRIES IN THIS FIELD. THEY FURTHER EXCHANGED VIEWS ON THE TERRITORIAL SEA AND THE FISHING ZONES ACT OF CDA WHICH RECENTLY CAME INTO FORCE.

18. THE MINISTERS OF THE TWO COUNTRIES EXPRESSED SATISFACTION THAT THIS MTG, LIKE THE TWO PREVIOUS MTGS, CONTRIBUTED GREATLY TOWARD BETTER UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN CDA AND JAPAN.

THE CTTEE ACCEPTED THE INVITATION OF THE CDN GOVT TO HOLD THE NEXT MTG IN OTT.
