all states.

Discussing the situation in Europe, the two sides found that there was an increased interest in the easing of tension and for the elimination of barriers to cooperation, which offered hope that with expanded and intensified contacts the way could be prepared for a successful conference or conferences on European security and cooperation.

The two sides confirmed their desire to see the 25th Anniversary of the United Nations strengthen that Organization's contribution to world peace and security and to wider cooperation among peoples.

The two Ministers were glad to note that, although their countries had different political systems they shared many interests and objectives and that the results of the visit were positive in contributing to mutual understanding and cooperation between Canada and the Socialist Republic of Romania.

The Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Socialist Republic of Romania accepted, with pleasure, the invitation to visit Canada extended by the Secretary of State for External Affairs of Canada.
