THE MINISTER OF STATE (INTERNATIONAL TRADE)
TO ATTEND TWO INTERNATIONAL MEETINGS
IN THE UNITED KINGDOM

The Honourable Gerald Regan, Minister of State (International Trade), will attend two international meetings on international trade in the United Kingdom.

From 14 to 16 July, he will be participating in an international conference organized by the London-based Trade Policy Research Centre at Leeds Castle, England. The theme of this conference will be "Protectionism, Disinflation, and the Financial System". Participation will include New Zealand Prime Minister Robert Muldoon, Philippine Prime Minister and Minister of Finance Cesar Virata, United States Trade Representative William Brock and other Ministers and senior officials from a number of developed and developing countries as well as representatives from the business community and independent specialists.

On the evening of 16 July and the morning of 17 July, Mr. Regan will attend a Quadrilateral Meeting of Trade Ministers. Other participants will be United States Trade Representative William Brock, the EC Commissioner Wilhem Haferkamp and the new Japanese MITI Minister, Mr. Sosuke Uno. Mr. Regan has offered the facilities of the Canadian High Commission in London as the locale for this meeting.
