

An Act to amend the Act thirty-third Victoria chapter
twenty respecting the relations of the Bank of Upper
Canada.

An amendment of the Act passed in the thirty-third year of His
Majesty's King, chapter twenty and entitled "An Act
in view to the Bank of Upper Canada, for the purpose of amending the
powers and authorities of the Bank of the Bank of
Upper Canada; that Majesty, by and with the advice and consent
of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as
follows:

1. A sum not exceeding two hundred and fifty thousand
dollars out of any unappropriated moneys forming part of the
Consolidated Revenue Fund of Canada is hereby appropriated to the
disposal of the Governor in Council for the purpose of paying off
any claims on the Bank of Upper Canada established and adjusted
under the fourth section of the Act passed above cited, and upon
payment being made on the certificate of the Treasury Board that
there is a sufficient fund for the redemption of the assets of
the Bank of the same as paid for any such claim.

2. A detailed account of the moneys expended under the
authority of this Act shall be laid before the House of Commons
of Canada during the first fifteen days of the next Session of
Parliament.
