

Fulmarus glacialis.**FULMAR.**

An Arctic species that occurs as far south as the Straits of Belle Isle, and, accidentally, in the Bay of Fundy.

Fulmarus glacialis minor.**LESSER FULMAR.**

A North Atlantic variety.

Fulmarus glacialis glupischa.**PACIFIC FULMAR.**

The western form of the common Fulmar. It occurs on the west coast of Vancouver Island.

Puffinus major.**GREATER SHEARWATER.**

This species is met with in summer on the Atlantic, from the Bay of Fundy to Greenland.

Puffinus puffinus.**MANX SHEARWATER.**

An accidental straggler to the Nova Scotia coast from the eastern side of the Atlantic.

Puffinus stricklandi.**SOOTY SHEARWATER.**

This is the "Black Hagdon" of the fisherman. KUMLIEN found it common from the Straits of Belle Isle to Grinnell Bay,
