An Act respecting the Montreal, Ottawa and Georgian Bay Canal Company.

WHEREAS the Montreal, Ottawa and Georgian Bay Canal Company has, by its petition, prayed that it be enacted as hereinafter set forth, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition: Therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

1. Section 1 of chapter 79 of the statutes of 1902, is repealed, and in lieu thereof it is enacted that if the construction of the Montreal, Ottawa and Georgian Bay Canal Company's canals, or some of them, is not commenced, and fifty thousand dollars are not expended thereon, on or before the first day of May, one thousand nine hundred and six, or if the said canals are not finished and put in operation by the first day of May one thousand nine hundred and twelve, then the powers granted by the Acts relating to the said company shall cease and shall be null and void as respects so much of the canals and works of the said company as then remains uncompleted.
