with the Arms of France, than the Affections of my Countrymen alienated from the present King, and his Royal Descendents, or his British Power weakened, by the Ruin of his British Subjects.

We have fuch undeniable Evidence of the Magnanimity of our prefent Sovereign that whoever has the Courage to speak this Language, may rest assured of his Approbation.

If we could suppose the Question to be humbly proposed to his Majesty, whether he would chuse to give up Great-Britain, for the Preservation of Hanover? his Answer would infallibly be Negative, and would rejoice every Heart in these Kingdoms, except only those desperate Men, who are striving so officiously to Out-Hanover each other.
