work with a will in prosecuting what evidently appears to be the design of Providence.

Napier, before D'Acre, exclaimed with more of heroism than reverence: "Fire away—and fulfil the prophecies."" In the same spirit, with more of faith and sacred respect for the manifest shaping of Divine ends, may we continue an agitation for the annexation of this Province to the United States. It is our Manifest Destiny. Geographical structure, commercial currents, historic events, a common language, and community of feeling and interests, all testify to the fact that is yet to be—the unition of the entire continent of America under one government.
