9. — The first Annual General Meeting of the shall he held fn the City of Ottawa. thereafter at least once fn every at place and time as the Executive mittee shali determine. Special meetings may he heid at any time at the head office, to he summoned hy the Executive Committee on a requisition in writing, setting forth the objects of the proposed meeting, signed by at least fifty memhers.

## BRANCHES.

10.—Branches may be established on requisition to the Executive Committee eigned by at least twenty-five persons, who ehali intimate their wieh to hecome members of the League. When such requieition is received by the Executive Committee, such Branch ehail he deemed to be formed. Upon receipt of notification from the Secretary of the Executive Committee that the requisition has been enrolled in the records of the League, a meeting of Branch shall he called for the purpose of organization. At euch meeting the persons present chall eiect a Precident, Vice-Preeidents, a Secretary and a Treasurer Branch, and a Committee of not fewer than five persons to manage the affaire of the Branch.

## MUMBERSHIP.

11.—The memhership of the League shall he composed of persons who approve of the Objects of the League and who subscribe and pay annually as follows:-

A yearly subscription of two dollare ehall entitle a subscriher to he an active member of the League and to

receive copies of official literature.

A person suhecrihing one dollar shali be deemed to he an Aesociate Member. Undergraduatee of an University becoming Associate Members chail he entitled to the official literature.

Life Memhership may he obtained hy a payment of one sum of twenty-five dollars, or hy five consecutive annual

paymente of five doliars.

12.-In ail cases the subscriptions for ladies shall be at half rates, except in the case of Active Memhere.

13.—Any person who approves of the Ohjects of the League and contributee not lese than fifty dollars, either in one eum or in five coneecutive equal annual paymente, may be appointed Honorary Vice-President of the League for life.
