The leaders of the political party having a numerical majority in the House shall form a Government, and shall arrange the business to be brought before the House at each session, giving due consideration and precedence to the motions of private members. It shall be the duty of the Government to resign office immediately after defeat upon any measure or resolution introduced by them officially or to which they have given their official support, or upon any vote showing a want of confidence; they shall then be succeeded in office by the opposite party.

IX. - ORDER OF BUSINESS.

The order of business at every session of this House, except extra sessions, shall be as follows:—

- I. Questions to Ministers and notices of questions.
- 2. Proposal of new members.
- 3. Notices of motion.
- 4. Orders of the day.

X.-ANNUAL MEETING.

The Annual Meeting of the Society shall be held on the second Tuesday in the month of October of every year, when the Officers will be elected, and other regular business transacted.
