with the appropriation of the money allotted for the expences of the house where the Society meets, and shall account to the Treasurer. They shall also visit sick Members, at the desire of the President, In case of the death and report to him. of any Member, they shall, if their services are required, give their personal attendance and aid to effect his decent Burial.

Officers.

ART. 7. In the absence of the Presi-Absence of dent, the Vice President shall preside. If they are both absent, the Members present shall chuse a President for the Meeting.

Motions.

ART. 8.
