

gate to the Central Association for each full paid up ten members, provided such subordinate association is not in arrears to the Central Association. Such delegates shall be entitled to vote by proxy.

For the purpose of electing delegates to the Central Association, all life members of the Central Association shall be considered members of the subordinate association where they reside.

17. A subordinate association may hold other meetings at the discretion of the President and Secretary-Treasurer.

18 All sections from (18) to (34) inclusive of this constitution and the by-laws apply to the Central and also subordinate association.

19. A resolution committee, consisting of the executive and Board of Directors, and such other persons as may be named by the President, shall meet the day previous to the annual meeting, and all resolutions intended to be brought before this committee, shall be in the hands of the Secretary ten days before the annual meeting.

DUTY OF OFFICERS

PRESIDENT

20. It shall be the duty of the President to preside at all meetings of the Association, decide all questions of order, and make any suggestions he may deem necessary in the interest of the association.
