

Sec. 4.—Any Member who shall refuse or neglect to comply with the Bye-Laws and Regulations, may be expelled by the vote of three-fourths of the Members present at an Extraordinary Meeting to be held for that purpose, or at an Ordinary Meeting, provided the same be notified the previous Meeting, and the said neglect of such Member be posted up at the usual place of Meeting at least fifteen days previously.

Sec. 5.—Every Member who shall be absent from the Province for more than a year shall pay only the sum of fifteen shillings per annum for every year he may have been so absent, to be paid within three months of his return. His neglect to pay the same, shall be considered as his withdrawal from Membership on the day of his departure from the Province.

Sec. 6.—Every Member who may wish to withdraw from the Corporation shall give notice thereof in writing, but his wish shall not be acceded to, until he shall have paid up his subscription to the expiration of the year in which the application to withdraw shall have been made.

CHAPTER 2ND,

OF OFFICERS.

Sec. 1.—It shall be the duty of the Presiding Officer when in the Chair, at any Meeting to regulate the order thereof, to inform the Board of the proceedings since the last Meeting, to cause the Reports of the Council and other communications to be read, and if needful, acknowledged, to receive and put motions, and to announce to the Meet-
