Exporters: E. L. Woodward bought for Swift & Co. 150 cattle for London market, 160 steers, averaging 1335 lbs., at \$5.15 average price.

Butchers: Prime picked lots, \$5.50 to \$5.75; loads of good to heavy, \$5.25 to \$5.50.

Good loads of butchering feeders sold at \$5.50 to \$5.75; steers, \$5.00 to \$5.25; hogs, \$4.75 to \$5.00.

There was an active market for sheep and lambs at \$4.75 to \$5.00 per cwt.; lambs, \$5 to \$5.25.

Mr. Harris reports prices lower at the market for hells, fat and watered, at \$2.25 to \$2.50; hogs, \$2.25 to \$2.50.

Representative Sales: McDonald and Halligan sold 13 cars of cattle, 1000 lbs. each, at \$5.25.
