The special feature of this Harness is the Saddle. Genuine English imported swell Van style made of grain sole leather with patent leather jockey 5½ in. wide and heavy blue serge bottom well stuffed and padded. The following description gives some idea of the great saving offered in an up-to-date delivery Harness.

Mountings are nickel: bridle has round patent leather blinds with box loop cheeks and face piece; nickel band front and large nickel rosettes; stiff or jointed bits; round side checks. Collar is open top, leather faced and has heavy harness leather back and rim. Hames are steel, high ball top; hame tugs are  $1\frac{1}{2}$  in. wide, with double grip buckles; traces are  $1\frac{1}{2}$  in., three-ply, with wrought iron cockeys. Good heavy two-ply sliding bearers  $1\frac{1}{4}$  in. wide. The shaft tugs are  $1\frac{1}{4}$  in. heavy, with heavy brass bar, buckles and billets for bellyband. Bellybands are good heavy folded with  $1\frac{1}{4}$  in. buckles. It has 1 in. back strap with buckled crupper and double hip straps. The breaching seat is made with heavy fold and  $1\frac{1}{8}$  in. layer and four neat hip tugs made with safe. Side straps are  $1\frac{1}{8}$  in. full length. The lines are 1 in. and good-solid leather full length with buckle and billet at bit.


