QUERIES REGARDING MILITARY SERVICE

Address Your Problems to the Military Editor of The Advertiser and They Will Be Answered From Official Information.

FARMER. Q.—I am 25 years of age and am exempted as long as I remain farming. When this work is finished am I at liberty to work at whatever capacity I desire?

RETURNED SOLDIER.—The military authorities here have informed The London Advertiser that all soldiers who are sent home from overseas and discharged as minors are not entitled to receive three months' post discharge pay, and therefore, you will have no claim for same, as this order covers your case.

T. H. E. Q.—I have been in the Canadian Engineers in this city for two months, and have now been discharged. Ten dollars had been deducted from my pay for my uniform, and on discharge I was informed by the paymaster that I had forfeited the ten dollars, although I had a kit clearance on discharge, and was never deficient in any way. If I am entitled to the ten dollars, to whom should I apply for a refund?

SUBSCRIBER. Q.—I have a son who died in the Canadian army while proceeding overseas. His body is buried in Liverpool, England, and I wish to bring the remains home to Canada. To whom would I apply for permission to do this?

READER. Q.—Have you any official information as to what will be done to defaulters who apprehend now that peace is declared?

CEGAR SPRINGS. Q.—Could you tell me when the 70th and 77th drafts which left London last July 27 are expected to return to Canada, as I have a son and friend in both drafts?

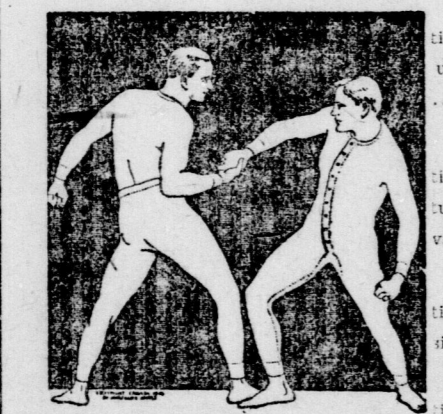
