## MISCELLANEOUS.

Grants from British Churches.—The Convener reported that he had received and suitably acknowledged a grant of £250 stg. from the Presbyterian Church in Ireland, and of £175 stg. from the Free Church of Scotland. He further reported that the United Presbyterian Church of Scotland had agreed to make a grant of £50 stg. for four years, to each of two Missionaries to be sent out by them to labour in connection with the Presbyterian Church in Canada. The report was received and gratification expressed therewith.
