greater extent than before. Besides wood, which has been used to a very large extent on the private railways, peat has also been employed with success. The minor private railways, in the south of Sweden in particular, have led the way, but larger railways, too, have followed suit, as for instance a South Swedish private railway, with a mileage of 412 km., has found this fuel so practical that it considers it can entirely pass over to peat-firing and thus find a substitute for coal both with fast express trains and with heavy goods trains. The state railways have also had for some years past a factory working for the production of peat powder, a fuel which is considered to be quite as good as coal, but the production of which on a large scale involves considerable difficulties.
