

- Q. 45. Were there always loaded magazines in the stores?
A. 45. Yes. We were on Security Guard which went on Wed evening at 1800 hrs 20 May.
- Q. 46. At any time around the 20-21 May did you have a leave coming up?
A. 46. I had a leave coming in June and was trying to get it fixed up for the middle of June which was my birthday.
- Q. 47. At that time were you aware of the fact that there was money being sent you?
A. 47. Yes, I had been written and told that it was coming.
- Q. 48. Was there any special spot to which you had intended going?
A. 48. Yes, to London.
- Q. 49. What is your nationality?
A. 49. American.
- Q. 50. How long have you been in the Canadian Army?
A. 50. 14 Months on 7 Jun 42.

Cross-examination:

- Q. 51. When you were ~~out~~ of the picquet you say you had to stay awake from 1800 hrs until 0600 hrs the next morning; did you not have a chance to sleep from 0600 hrs till 1330 hrs the same day?
A. 51. In my position I had no chance to get any sleep because of being in the stores and people coming in and out.

No re-examination:

Questioned by the Court:

- Q. 52. How old are you?
A. 52. I will be 26 on 16 Jun.
- Q. 53. What had you been drinking?
A. 53. I usually drink beer with a double or single gin in it.
- Q. 54. Do you know how many you had drank?
A. 54. No, I do not know.
- Q. 55. Do you know what was in the bottle which you drank outside the pub?
A. 55. I do not know if it was brandy or whiskey.
- Q. 56. How many drinks did you have out of the bottle?
A. 56. I could not say.
- Q. 57. To what extent do you usually drink?
A. 57. I usually stick to beer.
- Q. 58. Have you at any time while drinking had any experience with blackouts?
A. 58. Yes.
- Q. 59. How long have they lasted?
A. 59. Sometimes until morning but I usually manage to get home.
