

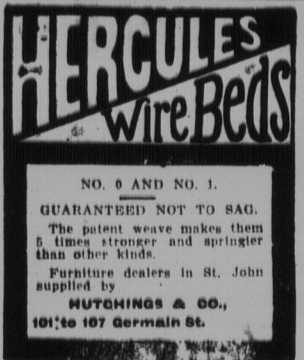

CHICAGO, March 15.—The steel frame work in many of the big buildings in the business district of Chicago is rotting, making them very dangerous.

"The steel frame work imbedded in concrete will last 2,000 years," he said.
