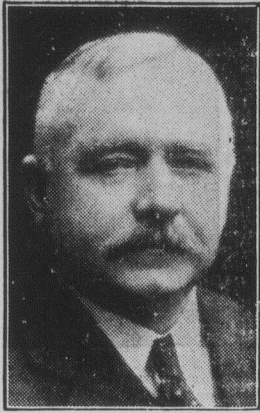

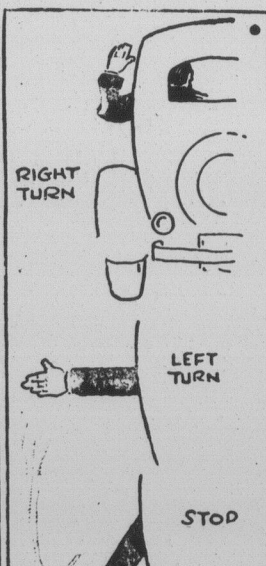
NEW YORK EDITOR TO FISH ON RESTIGOUCHE Fredericton, N. B., July 11. - Fred Fletcher, Rod and Gun Editor of the New York News, and one of the best known writers on sport fishing in America, is coming to New Brunswick to fish the salmon waters of the Restigouche.

Mr. Fletcher will head a party of four who are to spend part of next week on the open water of the Restigouche River. Included in the party will be Miss Josephine Patterson, daughter of the owner of the New York News and the Chicago Daily News, Mrs. Joseph Brooks, and Percy Pyne.

Mr. Fletcher is no stranger to New Brunswick, having fished on the Restigouche in 1927 in company with Frank Cheek, of coffee fame, and Webster Hall, crack camera man for Fox News. Back in 1928 Mr. Fletcher also came to New Brunswick and fished salmon on the Restigouche in company with Rex Beach, well known author and Gene Byrnes, cartoonist who popularized the comic strip "Reglar Fellers."

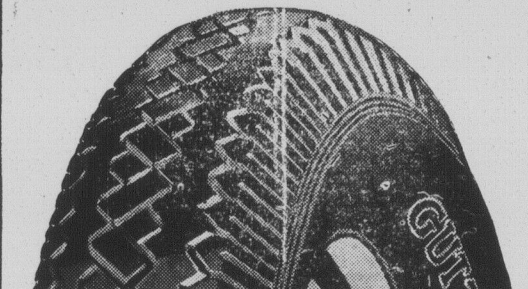

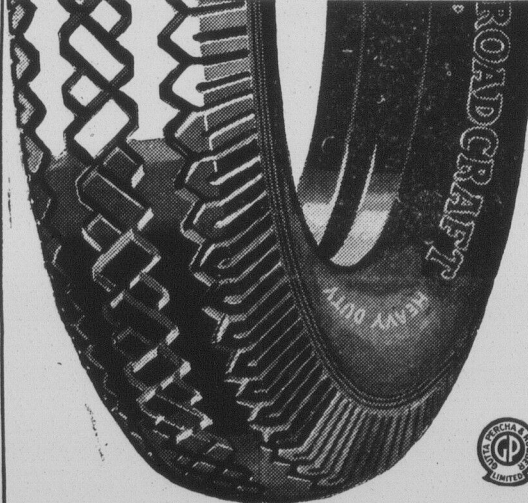

RED LADY LOBSTER REPOSES AS AN OBJECT OF CURIOSITY

Halifax, N. S., July 12. - They have at least caught a live red lobster. The lady was taken along the eastern shore of Nova Scotia recently. Arriving in a crate among a number of others, it was not noticed for some time, with the result that authorities are unable to identify the exact location from which it was taken.

DON'T GET LOCKED OUT Service experts report a few cases where owners have accidentally locked themselves out of their cars. When this condition was "invented," it was found that by turning down the outside door handle and letting it slip with a snap, the rebound motion forced the inside control handle up into the locked position. This locking condition, which is not often found, is brought about by improper mounting of the remote control unit on the regulator board, and may be corrected easily by re-adjusting the remote control unit so that it does not exert any push or pull on the door lock bolt.

NEPHEW OF GOV. GENERAL FISHING ON MIRAMICHI RIVER

Fredericton, N. B., July 12. - Hon. Arthur Ponsonby, nephew of His Excellency the Earl of Bessborough, Governor General of Canada, heads a party of three now fishing salmon on the Miramichi River with Jack Russell as guide.

Hon. Mr. Ponsonby accompanied by B. Baring and W. B. Harris, who also have been the guests of His Excellency at Rideau Hall Ottawa, arrived on the Miramichi river yesterday. Last evening Mr. Harris landed the first salmon of the party killing a 9 pound fish at Punter's Cove. The trio reached Quebec a few days ago from England and came directly to New Brunswick and they plan to spend a week or more fishing on the Miramichi River. They leave tonight for the upper stretches of the river.

Here and There

AUTOMATIC HARBOR LIGHTS - DEVICE NOT GENERALLY KNOWN. A device little known outside the Lighthouse maintenance world has been described here by E. Saver, resident engineer responsible to the Imperial Lighthouse Service for the constant burning of all lights in the Bahamas and many in the Virgin Islands group.

NEWLYWEDS ARE HAPPY ONIONS CAUSE WEeping. Montreal, July 12. - "Enough onions to make everybody in Canada weep for a week, and yet by no means are cord shipment," so local vegetable brokers describe a consignment of 375,000 Bermuda onions brought here by the C. N. liner Lady Somers.

TO BE TRIED IN YOUR KITCHEN. FROSTED PINEAPPLE. 1/2 cup white sugar, 1 cup boiling water. Cook until it forms a thread from spoon. Add pineapple flavoring or juice from fruit. Pour this over two beaten eggs and left cool. Whip 1 pt. cream stiff and mix with the above. Place in refrigerator to freeze. This makes a beautiful frozen dessert.

SPICE CAKE. 4 cups flour, 1 teaspoon each: magic soda, mace, cloves, cinnamon, ginger, 1/2 teaspoon salt, 2 cups brown sugar, 1 cup butter, 2 eggs, 1 cup sour milk, 1 cup each: raisins, currants, citron.

STRAWBERRY WATER ICE. 1 tsp. almond extract, 1 tsp. vanilla, 1 quart strawberries, 1/2 cup orange juice. Boil the sugar and water together for three minutes and cool. Hull the berries and press through a sieve. Add the syrup and orange juice and pour into a freezing tray. Set the Temperature Selector at No. 1 and place the strawberry mixture in the Automatic Freezer. Allow to remain there until frozen one inch. With the mixer - St-Que volod.
