1. Three Parsonages have been secured during the year. One (at Truro), a new erection to replace an old building which was sold and the proceeds expended upon the new buildings, etc. One (at Andover), new, where no parsonage had previously been, and one (at Cornwall, P. E. I.), secured by purchase; here also no Parsonage had been previously provided. These properties have been duly made over to the Connexion; and Certificates of Registry are in the hands of the Secretary of the Fund. The cost has been \$4340.00, which has been provided for as follows:

2. Six other erections, at an estimated cost of \$6880.00, have been authorized by the Committee; two to replace old buildings; and four in places hitherto unprovided with Ministers' residences.
