IV. Autumn Meeting, 1892, Montreal.

The Board of Management met in St. George's School House, Montreal, on Wednesday, Sept. 14th, at 8 p.m., the Bishop of Toronto in the chair.

The following members were present: The Bishops of Toronto, Huron and Niagara, the General Secretary, and General Treasurer. Ven. Archdeacon Kaulbach, Diocese of Nova Scotia; Rev. Canon Von Iffland, Judge Hemming, Captain Carter, Diocese of Quebec; Rev. Canon Sweeny, Hon. G. W. Allan, Diocese of Toronto; Mr. W. M. Jarvis, Diocese of Fredericton; Very Rev. Dean Carmichael, Diocese of Montreal; Very Rev. Dean Innes, Mr. Chancellor Cronyn, Mr. M. Wilson, Diocese of Huron; Rev. Rural Dean Pollard, Mr. Chancellor Walkem, Mr. R. V. Rogers, Diocese of Ontario; Rev. Canon Houston, Diocese of Niagara. Every diocese, with the exception of Algoma, was represented.

1. The Triennial Report was read by the General Secretary, and after a few alterations was adopted by the Board.

2. A committee was appointed at the request of the Woman's Auxiliary, to meet a committee of their number to discuss questions of interest to the Society.

3. The affairs of the "Canadian Church Magazine and Mission News" were also referred to this committee.
