the Exportation of certain Quantities of Wheat and other Articles to His Majesty's Sugar Colonies in America, and to the Island of Saint Helena, and to the other Settlements belonging to the United Company of Merchants of England trading to the East Indies, and of Biscuit and Pease to Newfoundland, Nova Scotia, Bay Chaleur, and Labrador; and for indemnifying all Persons with respect to advising or carrying into Execution His Majesty's Orders of Council already made for allowing the Exportation of Wheat and other Articles;) have been found insufficient for the Use of the British Subjects carrying on the Fisherp at the Idio Mand of Newfoundland, Nova Scotia, Bay Chaleur, and Labrador; may it therefore please Bour Wajelly that it may be enacted; and be it enacted by the King's most Excellent Wajelly, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Cemporal, and Commons. in this present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority of the same, That, from and after the palling of this Ad, it thall and may be lawful to thip and export Wheat-Cour, Biead, Biscuit, and Pease, out of and from the several Ports in this Kingdom herein-after mentioned, to the feveral Places herein-after named, for the Benefit of the British Fishery carried on in those Parts, so as the same do not exceed the several Dyantities respectively limited to those Places in any One Pear, any Thing in the said recited Acts, oz either of them, to the contrary notwithstanding; (that is to sap),

Certain Quantimisof Wheat-flour, &c. allowed to be exported to Newfoundland, &c. for the Benefit of the Fishery, from the Ports herein-after mentioned.

To the Illand of Newfoundland, Kour hundled Duarters of Aheat-Cour, Two hundled and Lifty Tons of Biscuit, and Two hundled Duarters of Pease.

To Nova Scotia, Three hundred Duarters of Wheatflour, Two hundred Tons of Bilcuit, and Three hundeed Duarters of Peaks.

To Bay Chaleur, Kive hundzed Duarters of Atheatflour, Two hundzed Tons of Biscuit, and Two hundzed Quarters of Pease.

To Labrador, Two hundled Duarters of Aheatflour, Two hundled Tons of Bistuit, and Two hunvied Duarters of Pease.
