

EDWARDS, WILLIAM CAMERON. (*Russell.*)

S. of the late Wm. Edwards, a native of Portsmouth, Eng., who came to Can. about 1820, and of Martha Ann Cameron, his wife, a native of Fort William, Scot. B. in the Tp. of Clarence, Ont., 1844, and ed. at the Ottawa Grammar Sch. M., Jan., 1885, eld. dau. of William Wilson, Esq., of Cumberland. Is a lumber manufacturer. An unsuccessful candidate for present seat at g.e., 1882. First returned to Parlt. at g.e., 1887. The election being declared void, a new election was held 7 May, 1888, when he was re-elected. Re-elected at last g.e. A Liberal.—*Rockland, Ont.*; *Rideau Club*.

FAIRBAIRN, CHARLES. (*South Victoria.*)

Father came to Can. from Peeblesshire, Scot. Mother, a descendant of a U.E. Loyalist. B., 4 July, 1837. Ed. at Peterborough. M., 17 Nov., 1861, Esther Fee, of Tp. of Emily. Is a farmer. Was a Municipal Councillor for five years, and afterwards Reeve for twenty years of the Tp. of Verulam. Was an unsuccessful candidate for South Victoria at g.e., 1883 and 1890 for Leg. Assem., Ont. First returned to Parlt. at last g.e. A Liberal Conservative.—*Bobcaygeon, P.O.*

FAUVEL, WILLIAM LEBOUTILLIER, J.P. (*Bonaventure.*)

Descended from a Norman Huguenot family who came from Avranches in 1685 and settled in Jersey at the revocation of the Edict of Nantes. S. of John Fauvel, J.P., and Henriette Marie LeBoutillier, of the Island Jersey, both of whom lived at Gaspesia from 1823 to 1867. B. at Percé, Co. of Gaspé, 5 Jan., 1850. Ed. at Oxford House School, Jersey. M., 11 April, 1881, at St. Saviour's Episcopal Church, Jersey, Emma, only dau. of Philip du Heaume, late Major in Royal Jersey Militia. Is a merchant and shipowner and is manager of the Le Boutillier Brothers Co. (Limited), Quebec. Is Mayor of New Carlisle, Presdt. of the Agricultural Soc. No. 1, of Bonaventure, and Presdt. of the School Commrs. First returned to Commons at last g.e. A Liberal; favours Unrestricted Reciprocity and the reduction of the import duties. Is opposed to Protection.—*Paspébiac, P.Q.*

FEATHERSTON, JOSEPH. (*Peel.*)

Father was a native of the Co. of Durham, Eng.; mother a native of Irel. B. in the Tp. of Trafalgar, Co.
