An Act to amend the Act of 1856, relating to Agricultural Societies in Lower Canada.

HEREAS it is unjust that when two Agricultural Societies exist Preamble. in any County, and the population within the limits of the one Society greatly exceeds that within the limits of the other, the Provincial Grant should be divided equally between them; Therefore Her Majesty, 5 &c., enacts as follows:

1. So much of the sixth section of the Act of 1856, intituled "An Act Part of sect. to amend the Act to provide for the better organization of Agricultural 6, of 19 & 20 Societies in Lower Canada, and for other purposes connected with Agriculture in Lower Canada," as provides that when there are two Agri-Provincial 10 cultural Societies in any County, they shall be entitled to receive each grant divided an equal share of the Annual Grant, not exceeding one hundred pounds, according to shall be repealed: and whenever there shall be two Agricultural Societies in any County in Lower Canada, the Annual Provincial Grant shall be divided between them in proportion to the population within 15 the limits of each, according to the then last census, subject always to the provisions of the said sixth section, in case only one Society shall be in operation in any year, or one of the Societies shall not have subscribed the amount sufficient to entitle it to receive the whole of its share of the said Annual Grant.
